Strep Throat

Strep throat is an infection of the throat. It is caused by a germ.

HOME CARE


- > Gargle with 1 teaspoon of salt in 1 cup of warm water. Do this 3 to 4 times per day or as necessary for comfort.
- > If you have tender swollen glands in your neck, you may apply a heating pad or warm towels several times per day. **Do not sleep with a heating pad** as burns may occur.
- > Family members with a sore throat or fever should see a doctor.
- > You may return to work when you feel able.
- > Only take medicine as directed by your doctor.

GET HELP IF:

- > A temperature above 102° F (38.9° C) that lasts 2 days or more and is not controlled by medicine.
- > You get large glands in your neck.
- > You get a rash, cough, or earache.
- > You cough up green, yellow-brown, or bloody sputum.
- > You have pain not controlled by medicine or if problems seem to be getting worse rather than better.

GET HELP RIGHT AWAY IF

- > You have new symptoms such as throwing up, bad headaches.
- > Stiff or painful neck, chest pain, trouble breathing.
- > You have severe throat pain, drooling or changes in voice.
- > Your neck swells.
- > Your neck becomes red and tender.
